

Detailed guidelines for filling out the proposal entry form in a call for launching research groups on the strefaID platform:

Proposals shall be drawn up **in English**. In individual cases specified in the call announcement proposals may be drawn up in Polish.

The proposal comprises four sections:

- I. The applicants' data and basic information on the project.
- II. Detailed description (the proposal's merit-based value evaluated using scoring of **0-40** points).
- III. EI.JU goal completion (evaluated using scoring of **0-15** points)
- IV. Applicant and team members' research achievements (*evaluated using scoring of **0-15** points*)
- V. Project implementation plan and schedule (*evaluated using scoring of **0-15** points*).
- VI. Project cost estimate (*relevance evaluated using scoring of **0-15** points*).

Description of the research consists of three parts: Project aims, Detailed description (Thematic scope of the project, Description of research methods and tools, Project's relevance to the EI.JU program goals, the '4I' principle, and the program indicators, The project's relevance to the Heritage PRA thematic scope, Additional information)

The proposal's merit-based value for this part of the project, taking into account its compliance with the EI.JU Strategy and goals, will be assessed using scoring from 0 to 40 points.

In the 'Project aims' section enter individually the aims of the research group activity and the measures by which they will be achieved.

II. Detailed description (merit-based evaluation: 0 – 40 points)

'Thematic scope of the project' (from 5,400 to 7,200 characters with spaces) as prescribed below:

1. Presenting the research problem and the questions around which the project is organised.
2. Description of the project's innovative nature: international state of the art and significance of the planned actions for the advancement of science.
3. Relevance of the research group activities to the implemented or planned research projects (if applicable).

Concept of the project and new activities implementation (from 1,800 to 3,600 characters with spaces)*

Proposed research group activities (conferences, study visits) and their relevance for achieving the goal.

III. Project's relevance to the EI.JU program goals, the '4I' principle, and the program indicators (up to 3,600 characters) (evaluated using scoring of **0 – 15 points**):

1. Relevance of the expected project results, especially of the emerging publications or grant proposal to goals of the EI.JU strategic programme (taking into account the points described in detail under the headings 'Products' and 'Project results') and the programme indicators (justification of the publication outlet selection).
2. Internationalisation of the team preparing a joint publication or a grant proposal
